- Be 18 years of age or older
- High school diploma or equivalent (GED)
- Demonstrate ability to perform college level course work through previous GPA and/or college entrance testing
- Be of good moral character (background check required)
- Be self motivated and responsible for your own learning
- Be conversant in written and oral English
- Meet immunization & health requirements
- Completion of a Massage Therapy program of at least 500 hours of education
- 40 hours of pathology (those not meeting this requirement can take it as a co-requisite)
- Michigan Licensure (before certificate of completion will be issued)
- Professional Liability Insurance
- Two Letters of Recommendation (Forms available at the school)

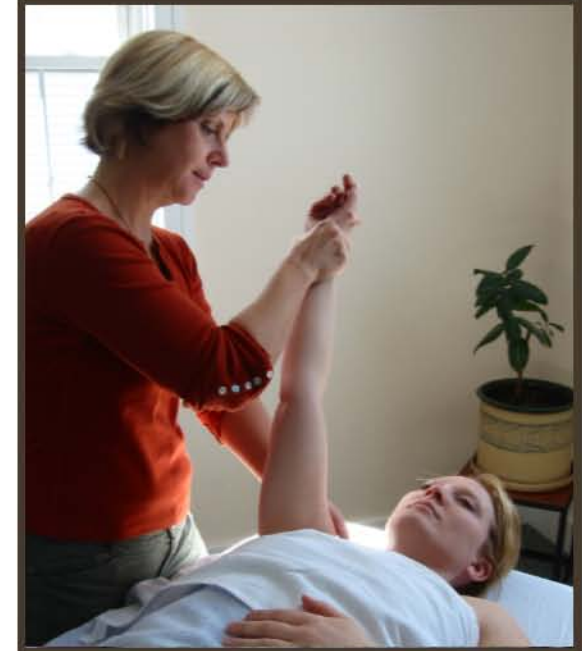
Lakewood School of Therapeutic Massage in Clinical Affiliation with Port Huron Hospital offers a course in Hospital Based Massage.

Our 72 clock hour Hospital Based Massage Course is designed to prepare the Massage Therapist for working with patients in a hospital and/or other medical setting.

In Clinical Affiliation with Port Huron Hospital, Massage Therapists taking this program will receive 32 hours of clinical practice along with 40 hours of classroom instruction that will occur at the school.
